

State of Kansas - List of Applicable Codes for construction projects on State of Kansas property
Department of Administration, Office of Facilities and Property Management

The following list of codes is adopted by the Office of Facilities and Property Management. The code editions must be listed on the code footprint and must be listed on the title page of each discipline's construction documents.

- A. International Building Code (IBC), 2006 Edition.
 - a. Chapter 11, Accessibility, is deleted. See Item L below.
 - b. Additionally, The Life Safety Code (NFPA 101) will also be applicable for occupancies described in Item I and J below.
- B. International Building Fire Code (IFC), 2006 Edition.
- C. International Residential Code (IRC), 2006 Edition.
- D. International Mechanical Code (IMC), 2006 Edition.
- E. International Plumbing Code (IPC), 2006 Edition.
- F. International Fuel Gas Code (IFGC), 2006 Edition.
- G. International Energy Conservation Code (IECC), 2006 Edition or ASHRAE 90.1-2007
- H. The codes and standards referenced in the Referenced Standards Chapters in the IBC, IFC, IRC, IMC, IPC, IFGC and IECC shall be applicable except for NFPA codes noted in Item I and J below. The NFPA editions noted in Item I and J shall be applicable.
- I. National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), National Fire Codes and Standards for occupancies other than Healthcare occupancies described in Item J.
 - a. NFPA 10 – 2007 edition – Portable Fire Extinguishers
 - b. NFPA 13, 13D and 13R – 2007 edition - Installation of Sprinkler Systems
 - c. NFPA 14 – 2007 edition - Installation of standpipe and hose systems
 - d. NFPA 25 – 2008 edition – Testing Fire Sprinkler Systems
 - e. NFPA 70 – 2008 edition - National Electric Code (NEC)
 - f. NFPA 72 – 2007 edition – National Fire Alarm Code
 - g. NFPA 101 – 2006 edition – Life Safety Code—only applicable to adult and boarding care homes per KSFM K.A.R.–22-11-8.
 - h. NFPA 110 – 2005 – Emergency and Standby Power Systems
- J. National Fire Protection Association (NFPA), National Fire Codes and Standards applicable only for Healthcare Occupancies (i.e. hospitals, nursing homes, immediate care facilities) that receive Center for Medicaid/ Medicare Services (CMS) funding and inspections.
 - a. NFPA 10 – 1998 edition – Portable Fire Extinguishers
 - b. NFPA 13, 13D and 13R – 1999 Edition - Installation of Sprinkler Systems
 - c. NFPA 25 – 1998 edition – Testing Fire Sprinkler systems
 - d. NFPA 70 – 1999 edition – National Electric Code (NEC)
 - e. NFPA 72 – 1999 edition – National Fire Alarm Code
 - f. NFPA 101 – 2000 edition – Life Safety Code
 - g. NFPA 110 – 1999 edition – Emergency and Standby Power Systems
- K. Kansas Fire Prevention Code (This code combines many different documents including Kansas Statutes Annotated (K.S.A.) and Kansas Administrative Regulations (K.A.R.) A list of pertinent statutes and regulations can be found at the KSFM website at <http://www.accesskansas.org/firemarshal>.
- L. Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines for Buildings and Facilities (ADAAG), published in the Federal Register 7-26-91 (K.S.A. 58-1301 *et seq.*) and/or the Uniform Federal Accessibility Standards (UFAS), which also apply to agencies covered by Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973. On March 12, 2011 and thereafter, in addition to ADAAG, 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design may be used for applications not addressed in ADAAG/UFAS. On March 15, 2012 and thereafter, 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design will become federal law for accessibility requirements; however, state requirements cite ADAAG as the accessibility standard to use. 2010 ADA Standards for Accessible Design may only be used for applications not addressed in ADAAG.
- M. Kansas State Boiler Code (K.S.A. 44-913) available though Kansas Department of Labor (<http://www.dol.ks.gov> found under workplace safety-labor safety programs-boiler safety) and the ASME Boiler Pressure Vessel Code, as referenced in Kansas State Boiler Code.
